General Responsibilities

The ReStore Warehouse Coordinator is responsible for coordinating the donations received at the store, from entry into the store to pricing and stocking inventory onto the sales floor, and for providing an excellent customer service experience to both residential and corporate donors.

Specific Responsibilities

- Understand ReStore Policy and Procedures as well as oversee and help develop efficient processing of donated items from receiving area to the sales floor
